Consultant Description

Scope of Work:

The Behavioral Analyst Consultant is a contractor who provides leadership in the areas of behavioral health.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Develops individualized behavior plans. Using applied behavior analysis, these plans aim to guide residents toward changed behavior.
- Develops health care support goals and objectives with input from the resident,
 Filbert House staff, his health professionals, Probation Officer and updates the plan
 as needed providing a written report as per their Needs and Services Plan (as
 determined by the team and when appropriate)
- Utilize behavioral assessments to assess residents' social and behavioral development
- Conducts observations of residents' social and behavioral development in various settings to identify and mitigate behavioral challenges
- Review historical medical/health status including any psychotropic medications, restricted health care plans, communicable, acute or chronic illnesses or diseases upon referral and makes recommendations for implementation of care plans and training needed for staff
- Participates in the development of policies and procedures related to behavioral health
- Provides training to residents as needed around their health care regimes and other generic trainings (such as avoiding sexually transmitted diseases, etc.)
- Provides in-service training as needed

Consultant Specifications:

- The Behavioral Analyst Consultant shall possess the following minimum qualifications:
- Board Certification as a Behavioral Analyst in the State of California
- Ability to work as part of a multi-disciplinary-team including residents, their Circle of Support members, probation staff and community collaborators
- Knowledge of requirements for providing psychiatric care to residents, including



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ability to communicate with residents and sensitivity to their cultural (including language) beliefs, values and practices

- Maintains malpractice or professional liability insurance
- Ability to recognize and report suspected abuse
- Ability to provide three references from persons knowledgeable about his/her work
- Must be in good health with criminal record and fingerprint clearance
- Has current TB Clearance, certifications in First Aid/CPR, Valid California Drivers license, clean DMV printout and current registration and insurance
